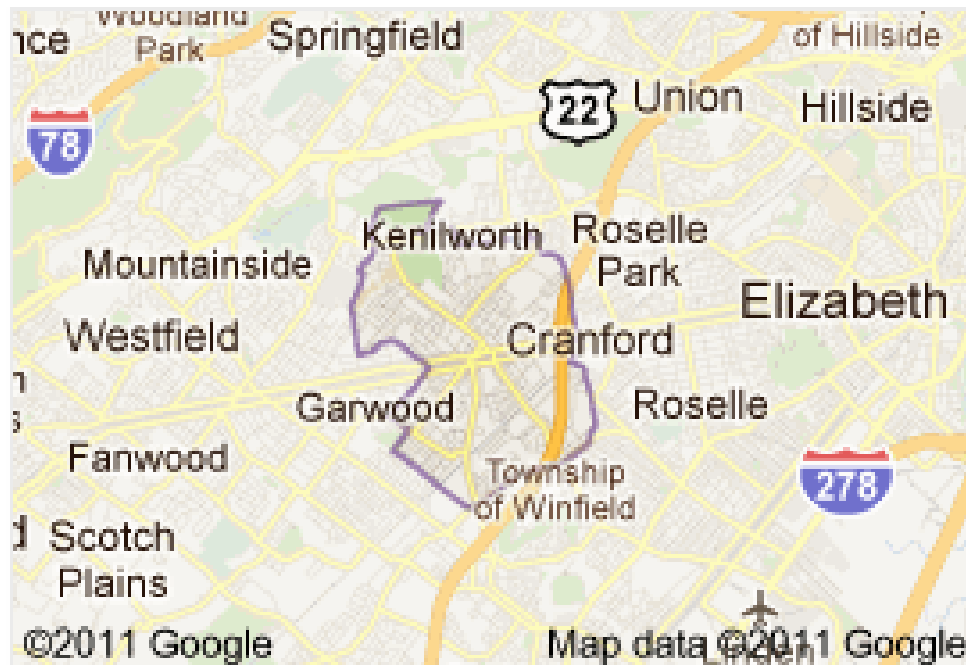

Select your "Green Business" Category:

GREEN: Implement 6 or more GREEN Steps:

- Turn off lights on nights & weekends
- Turn off computers and other office equipment at night and weekend
- Use programmable thermostat or control during unoccupied times
- Replace light bulbs with low energy fluorescent bulbs
- Use recycled paper
- Use Green cleaning supplies
- Recycle (business products as well as consumer waste)
- Promote walking, biking or carpooling to work
- Offer a wellness program
- Other Green initiatives specific to your business and industry
- Purchase local material/foods regularly (local = 5 mile radius)

GREENER: Implement 6 GREEN Steps plus 4 GREENER Steps:

- Implement Environmental Policy
- Place lights on motion detectors or install timers
- Complete an energy audit
- Implement waste management practices such as: reducing waste generated, reducing product packaging, reducing paper waste, increasing recycling, purchase recycled materials
- Implement actions to conserve water; low flow toilets, aerators for faucets, etc.
- Offer programs to educate employees on sustainable practices at work and home
- Support community and/or sustainable programs @
- Commitment to local economy such as purchasing products from local suppliers

- Ask several times
 - Chamber of Commerce didn't come on board all at once
