**WHEREAS**, the Town of Secaucus wishes to eliminate Styrofoam from schools, restaurants and small businesses within the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, Polystyrene cannot be recycled in Hudson County or in the surrounding nearby counties; and

**WHEREAS**, Polystyrene products are unnecessary and can be replaced with paper or other alternative biodegradable products.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town of Secaucus be and is hereby certified with Sustainable Jersey to put a ban on Styrofoam in the Town of Secaucus.


