From the Northeast Corridor NJ Transit train

Walk down stairs to Main Street. Turn toward downtown and walk north one block to the traffic light. Turn left onto New Street. The Senior Center is two blocks on the right.

From the North - NJ Turnpike South to Exit 4 (keep left at the fork in the ramp). Merge onto NJ-73 South. Follow NJ-73 South about 3 miles (go through Rt 70 intersection). Make left at traffic light (Main St - Marlton Business District). Follow Main St about 2 miles to Recreation Dr. (Indian Springs Driving Range).

Using Rt 295 South take Exit 36A. Merge onto NJ-73 South. Follow above.

From the South - Using Rt 295 North take Exit 34A. Merge onto NJ-70 East. Make right on Rt 73, then make left at traffic light (Main St - Marlton Business District). Follow Main St about 2 miles to Recreation Dr. (Indian Springs Driving Range).

From the West: Take 80 East to Exit 38 onto Route 46 East. At 2nd traffic light take left to Denville. Take an immediate left onto West Main St. Proceed to second right, St Mary's Place. Parking is behind the building.

From the East: 287 North/South to 80 West. On 80 West, take Exit 42B/Parsippany. Left at second light onto Route 46 West. Go 2.8 miles (through 5 traffic lights) make right onto St Mary's Place, parking is behind the building.
