**From NJ Tpk:** NJ Tpk to exit 2. Take Rte 322 East to Rte 55 S. Take 55 S to exit 32A. Follow the exit ramp onto Landis Ave East, toward Vineland. The Ramada Inn is on your left.

**From GS PKWY:** Take GSP to the Atlantic City Expressway West. On AC Expressway take exit 23 (Mays Landing Rte. 40W). Follow Rte 40 West past Rte 50 and Rte 552. Go 12 miles to next traffic light and turn left onto Cedar Rd./Rte 540. Go straight through next light. You are now on Landis Ave. Go 10 miles, through Vineland City, after junction at Rte. 47 the Ramada is 1 mile ahead on the right.
